

Emergency Kit and Breakdown Steps

What to carry, and exactly what to do when a vehicle quits on the road.

IF YOU BREAK DOWN

- ☐ Signal early and move right toward the shoulder
- ☐ Hazard lights on as soon as trouble starts
- ☐ Get as far off the travel lane as possible
- ☐ Stay belted inside if traffic is fast or heavy
- ☐ Exit on the passenger side when it is safe
- ☐ Set reflective triangles well behind the car
- ☐ Call for a tow, then call the shop

CORE KIT

- ☐ Jumper cables or a lithium jump pack
- ☐ Tire inflator and pressure gauge
- ☐ Reflective triangles or flares
- ☐ LED flashlight and spare batteries
- ☐ Work gloves and shop towels
- ☐ Multi tool and basic sockets
- ☐ Duct tape and zip ties

COMFORT AND SAFETY

- ☐ Bottled water and non-perishable snacks
- ☐ First aid kit
- ☐ Blanket and rain poncho
- ☐ Phone charger and backup battery
- ☐ Printed copy of insurance and roadside numbers

KNOW BEFORE YOU NEED IT

- ☐ Where your spare, jack and lug key live
- ☐ Whether your car has a spare at all
- ☐ Your roadside assistance coverage
- ☐ Your preferred shop's number saved in your phone
